DIGITALLI is an Erasmus+ KA2 Cooperation Partnership in Adult Education (Project No. 2024-1-AT01-KA220-ADU-000254167), coordinated by Meta4 Innovations (Austria) with partners from Cyprus (UNIC), Slovenia (CIK Trebnje), Ireland (The Rural Hub), and Greece (CARDET360).

The project supports adult learning providers in their journey toward digital transformation and AI-driven innovation, promoting inclusive and ethical lifelong learning in line with the European Digital Education Action Plan.

Aims and Objectives

DIGITALLI aims to bridge the gap between the digital skill demands of today's labour market and the preparedness of adult learning providers.

It builds institutional capacity and strengthens educators' and learners' competences – especially for those at risk of digital exclusion.

At its core, the project promotes ethical, inclusive and future-oriented digital strategies in adult education.

Toolkit for Digital Transformation

The DIGITALLI Toolkit has completed its pilot phase across all five partner countries.

Partners are now collecting and analysing feedback to finalise the Toolkit – a hands-on guide for assessing and improving institutional digital readiness.

It covers four key areas:

- Human capital
- Infrastructure & technology
- Organisational processes
- Institutional culture

The final version will soon be available as a practical resource for adult learning institutions across Europe.

The Digital Expert System

Work on WP3 has begun!

The DIGITALLI Digital Expert System will offer AI-powered, tailored guidance to adult learning institutions, helping them evaluate their digital maturity and plan their next steps.

This interactive platform will act as a smart companion for strategic decision-making in education.
